Like all other health facilities Paray Mission Hospital is affected by the current pandemic's devastating and painful consequences. Nevertheless, despite its many challenges, Covid-19 brought with it new and lasting developments as well.

Priceless help and new assets: Support from various companies who provided PPE (personal protective equipment), essential medical equipment and infrastructure to fight the pandemic are very much appreciated:

- Misesan Cara through Oblates in Ireland: supported with essential medical equipment and a mobile screening (testing) center at the main entrance of the hospital.
- Metropolitan: supported with ventilators and PPE also.

Multiple projects in process are:

- donation of various essential medical equipment,
- installation of 2 special "royal tents" (20 patients each) with heating system
- purchase of standard beds and lockers,
- 45 oxygen cylinders that the company refills as per need,
- construction of a permanent structure that will accommodate 60 patients,
- renovation of hospital chapel,
- installation of oxygen plant,
- construction of laundry; furniture will be included
- pavement of the hospital grounds.
